Classroom Rules

I (the teacher) have the right to teach.

Every student here has the right to learn.

No one has the right to violate either of these.

Behavioral Plan

- 1. Should behavior become disruptive, one verbal warning will be issued. Detention will be assigned upon second infraction.
- 2. Detention will be served before or after school, separate from any tutorial time.
- 3. First detention will be for 15 minutes. Parents will be notified upon each successive detention. The second detention will be for 30 minutes. The third detention will be for 45 minutes.
- 4. After three detentions, an office referral will be made and a request for ISS will be issued.

Academic Plan

- 1. All students are expected to follow all safety rules. Failure to do so can result in detention, office referral, or ISS.
- 2. All students are expected to study for a minimum of 15 minutes per night.
- 3. All students are expected to turn in homework on time. Each day late will result in 10 points subtracted from the grade. (3 days late means 30 points off.) Excused absences will follow the school guidelines for making up missed work.
- 4. All students are expected to participate in class discussions and group work.
- 5. When group work is assigned for a long term projects, all students will sign a project accountability contract. Consequences for lack of participation will result in a lower grade.
- 6. Exams may not be retaken, however, to improve a grade, test corrections may be done to receive half the points back that were lost. (If you make an 80, you lost 20 points. Test corrections can allow you to earn back 10 of those points.)
- 7. The student is responsible for finding out what was missed during an absence. No exemptions.
- 8. If your grade falls below an 80, I expect to see you before or after school for tutorials. I will do my utmost to find a way to help you succeed.
